## Investment objective

The Fund aims to track as closely as possible the returns of the MSCI AC Asia Pacific ex Japan Climate Paris Aligned Index (the Index). The Fund will invest in or gain exposure to shares of companies which make up the Index. The Fund qualifies under Article 8 of SFDR.



# Investment strategy

The Index is a subset of the MSCI AC Asia Pacific ex-Japan Index (Parent Index) and made up of shares of large and mid-sized companies from certain developed and emerging market countries in the Asia Pacific region (excluding Japan). The Index is designed to support investors seeking to pursue opportunities arising from the transition to a lower-carbon economy while aligning with the Paris Agreement requirements. It excludes shares of companies with exposure to controversial weapons, ESG controversies, tobacco, environmental harm, thermal coal mining, oil and gas, and power generation. The Fund will be passively managed and will aim to invest in the shares of the companies in generally the same proportion as in the Index. The Fund may invest in China A-shares, up to up to 35% in securities from a single issuer during exceptional market conditions, up to 10% in other funds and up to 10% in total return swaps and contracts for difference. ## Main risks

- The Fund's unit value can go up as well as down, and any capital invested in the Fund may be at risk.
- The value of investible securities can change over time due to a wide variety of factors, including but not limited to: political and economic news, government policy, changes in demographics, cultures and populations, natural or human-caused disasters etc.






