Investment objective

The Fund aims to provide long term capital growth by investing in a portfolio of smaller company shares of Asia (excluding Japan), while promoting environmental, social and governance (ESG) characteristics. The Fund qualifies under Article 8 of SFDR.




Investment strategy

The Fund is actively managed. In normal market conditions, the Fund will invest at least 90% of its assets in shares of companies that are based in in Asia (excluding Japan), including both developed markets and emerging markets. The Fund will invest at least 70% in smaller sized companies. The Fund includes the identification and analysis of a company's environmental and social factors and corporate governance practices as an integral part of the investment decision making process. Companies considered for inclusion within the Fund's portfolio will be subject to excluded activities in accordance with HSBC Asset Management's Responsible Investment Policies. The Fund may invest up to 50% in China A and China B-shares, up to 10% in other funds, may invest in bank deposits and money market instruments for treasury purposes and up to 15% in Real Estate Investment Trusts. Main risks




