Investment objective

The Fund aims to provide long term capital growth and income through an active asset allocation in a diversified portfolio of bonds and shares, as well as money market and cash instruments.



Investment strategy

The Fund is actively managed and is not constrained by a benchmark. At least 70% of the Fund's exposure is to bonds and shares related to Asia-Pacific excluding Japan. The Fund may invest in non-Asian based assets. The Fund may invest in bonds that are investment grade, non-investment grade and unrated issued or guaranteed by governments, government-related and supranational entities, and companies based in developed markets and emerging markets. The Fund may invest up to 20% in onshore Chinese bonds and 10% in non-investment grade. The Fund may invest up to 15% in China A and China B-shares. The Fund may invest up to: 10% in convertible bonds; 10% in contingent convertible securities; 10% in non-investment grade bonds issued by a single government issuer; and can invest up to 10% in commodities and up to 10% in liquid alternative investment strategies. The Fund may invest up to 50% in other funds; 10% in real estate investment trusts and has a primary currency exposure to Asia-Pacific (excluding Japan) countries. 
Main risks

- The Fund's unit value can go up as well as down, and any capital invested in the Fund may be at risk.
- The Fund invests in bonds whose value generally falls when interest rates rise. This risk is generally greater the longer the maturity of a bond investment and the higher its credit quality. 





Equity geographical allocation (%)






