# Investment objective

The Fund aims to provide capital growth and income by investing in a portfolio of high yield securities that are related to the USA with an expected average duration of between 1 and 3 years whilst maintaining low interest rate risk.



# Investment strategy

The Fund is actively managed.

The Fund will invest at least 70% of its assets in non-investment grade and unrated bonds and similar securities issued by companies which are based in, or carry out the larger part of their business in the USA

The Fund may invest up to 10% in bonds issued by issuers that are based in emerging markets, up to 30% in investment grade bonds, up to 10% in bonds and other similar securities which have a maturity longer than five years and up to 10% in securities issued by any single government issuer with a non-investment grade rating.

Companies and/or issuers considered for inclusion within the Fund's portfolio will be subject to excluded activities in accordance with HSBC Asset Management's Responsible Investment

The Fund may invest up to 10% in convertible bonds, up to 15% in contingent convertible securities, up to 10% in asset-backed securities and mortgage-backed securities, up to 10% invested in other funds.

The Fund's primary currency exposure is to USD.

## Main risks

- The Fund invests in bonds whose value generally falls when interest rates rise. This risk is typically greater the longer the maturity of a bond investment and the higher its credit quality. The issuers of certain bonds, could become unwilling or unable to make payments on their bonds and default. Bonds that are in default may become hard to sell or worthless.
- The Fund may invest in Emerging Markets, these markets are less established, and often more volatile, than developed markets and involve higher risks, particularly market, liquidity and currency risks.
