# Investment objective

The Fund aims to provide long term capital growth and income by investing in a portfolio of bonds denominated in or hedged to Singapore dollars (SGD).



## Investment strategy

The Fund is actively managed.

In normal market conditions, the Fund will invest at least 90% of its assets in investment grade bonds, non-investment grade bonds, unrated bonds and other similar securities issued or quaranteed by governments, government agencies, supranational entities or issued by companies that are based in or carry out the larger part of their business in Asia, either denominated in SGD or non-SGD currencies that are hedged back to SGD.

Companies and/or issuers considered for inclusion within the Fund's portfolio will be subject to excluded activities in accordance with HSBC Asset Management's Responsible Investment Policies, which may change from time to time.


The Fund may invest up to 30% in non-investment grade bonds and similar securities and up to 10% in asset-backed securities and mortgage-backed securities. The Fund may invest up to 10% in convertible bonds and up to 10% in contingent convertible securities.

The Fund may invest up to 10% in other funds, including HSBC funds and may invest in bank deposits, money market instruments or money market funds for treasury purposes. See the Prospectus for a full description of the investment objectives and derivative usage.



## Main risks

- The Fund's unit value can go up as well as down, and any capital invested in the Fund may
- The Fund invests in bonds whose value generally falls when interest rates rise. This risk is typically greater the longer the maturity of a bond investment and the higher its credit quality. The issuers of certain bonds, could become unwilling or unable to make payments on their bonds and default. Bonds that are in default may become hard to sell or worthless
- The Fund may invest in Emerging Markets, these markets are less established, and often more volatile, than developed markets and involve higher risks, particularly market, liquidity and currency risks.
