# Investment objective

The Fund aims to make a positive environmental, social and governance (ESG) contribution, by investing in shares and other similar securities issued by companies that contribute to United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (Contributing Companies and SDGs), while also aiming to provide long-term capital growth and income. The Fund qualifies under Article 9 of SFDR.



# Investment strategy

The Fund is actively managed. The Fund's investment principles, together with sustainability analysis and fundamental qualitative company analysis are used to determine the Fund's investments and may include but are not limited to: engagement with Contributing Companies regarding their ESG standards; engagement with Contributing companies regarding their ESG standards at various stages of their ESG transition; companies following good ESG practices resulting in low and/or decreasing carbon intensity. The SDGs that Contributing Companies contribute to include, but are not limited to: Climate Action, Affordable and Clean Energy, Clean Water and Sanitation, Good Health and Well Being and Reduced Inequalities. Companies considered for inclusion within the Fund's portfolio will be subject to excluded activities in accordance with HSBC Asset Management's Responsible Investment Policies, which may change from time to time. The Fund may invest up to: 20% in China A and China B-shares; 10% in Real Estate Investment Trusts; and up to 10% in funds. ## Main risks







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


